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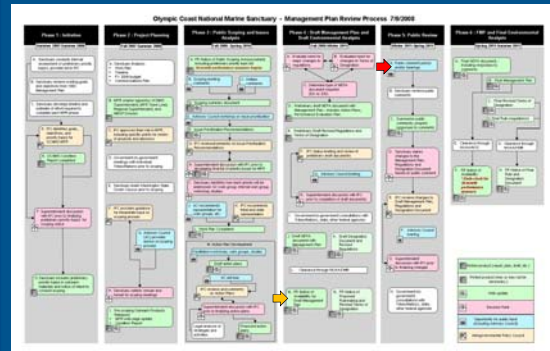

- Phase 1: Initiation

## Federal Register Notice

- Availability of proposed rule, draft environmental assessment and draft management plan
- How to access DMP/DEA
- Public comment period
- Methods for commenting, including public hearings

## Regulations Amendments

- Clerical
  - Size
  - Submerged lands
  - Lawful fishing
- Cruise ship discharge prohibition
- Tribal welfare permit requirements
- Minor changes to text

## Alternative A – No Action

- No revisions or changes to original OCNMS 1994 management plan
- No changes to original OCNMS goals (there were no objectives identified in the 1994 management plan)
- No changes to OCNMS regulations
- No action plans or performance measures
- Continuation of existing OCNMS programs

## Alternative B – Preferred

- Set of 20 action plans (Draft Management Plan)
- Revised goals and objectives
- Changes to regulations:
  - A regulatory ban of cruise ship discharges, w/exceptions
  - Update OCNMS address
  - Address inconsistent use of terms
  - Delete terms that no longer apply
  - Clarification of the tribal welfare clause

## Alternative C

- Alternative B, plus the following actions:
  - A regulatory ban of all large ship discharges, w/exceptions
  - A regulatory ban on the discharge of invasive species in the sanctuary
  - A regulatory change that would reduce the overflight floor over the sanctuary from 2000 feet to 1000 feet
  - A non-regulatory strategy to expand the applicability of the Area to be Avoided

## Public Review

- Public comment period began on **January 14**
- Anyone can comment on any aspect of either document during 60+-day public comment period
- Comments accepted by internet, letter, fax, or in person at public meeting
