- ✓ Support ecosystem health, sustainable resource based livelihoods, cultural integrity and coastal communities.



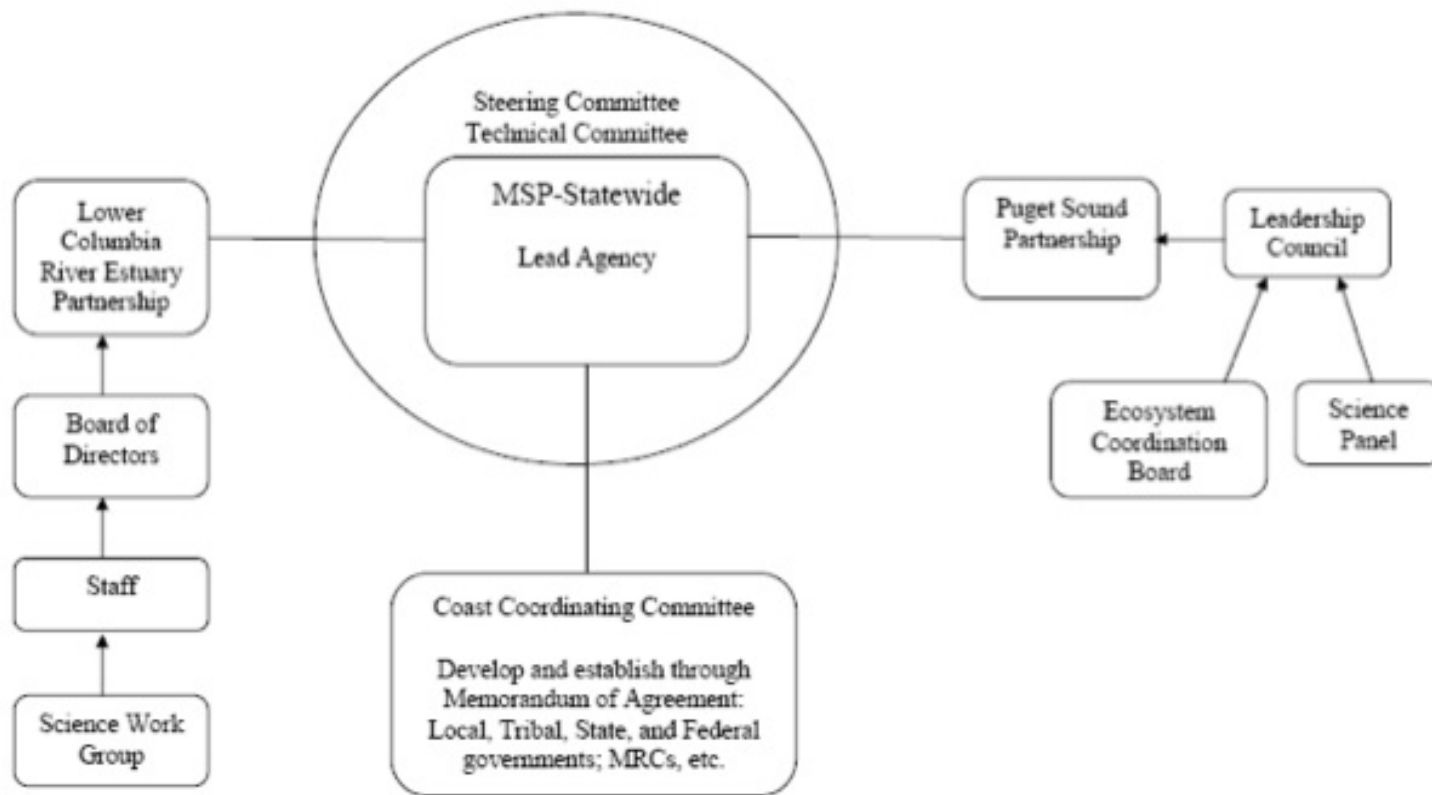
# Coastal & Marine Spatial Planning

Figure 2 - Governance Example for Marine Spatial Planning in Washington



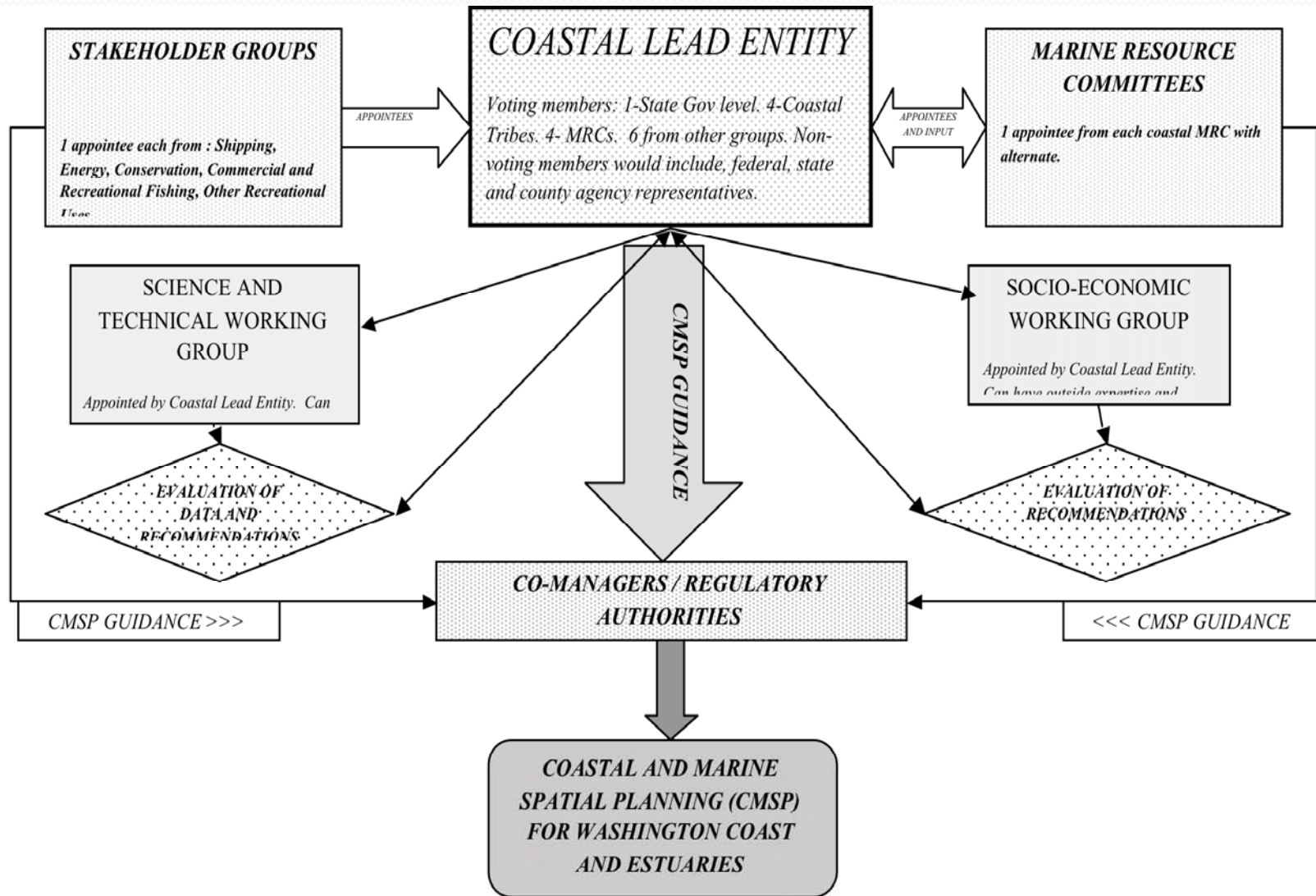

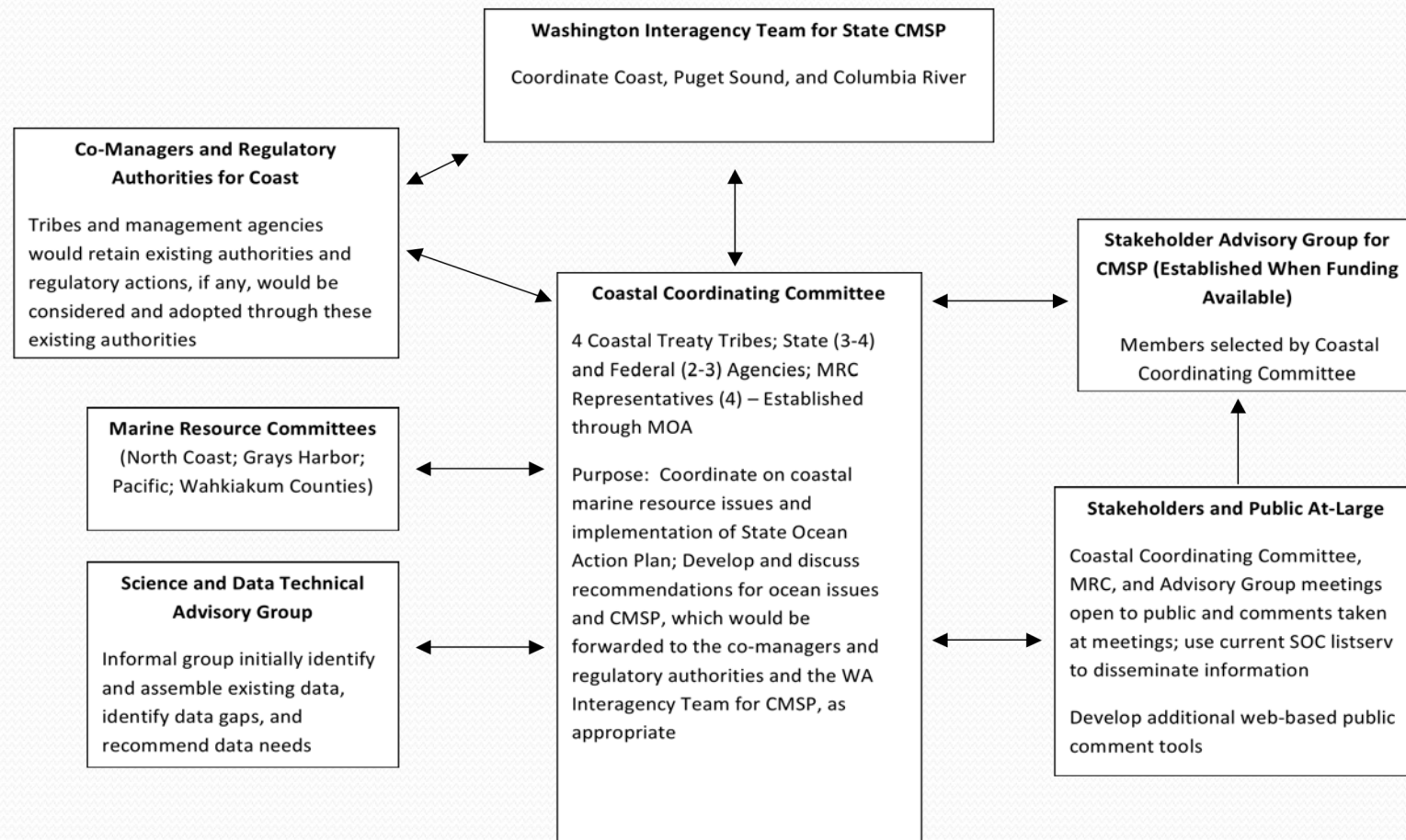
